The Hermès.com website is operated by the HERMÈS group. HERMÈS INTERNATIONAL, the parent of the HERMÈS group, hosts and operates the Hermès.com website, including processing and storing all of the data collected on or through the website. HERMÈS INTERNATIONAL has created this privacy policy ("Privacy Policy") in order to communicate the HERMÈS group's policies and practices relating to the collection, use and disclosure of information about you obtained on the Hermès.com website. Please read this Privacy Policy carefully. HERMÈS INTERNATIONAL may change or update this Privacy Policy periodically; see "Changes and Updates to Privacy Policy." If you decide to use the Hermès.com website, or by agreeing to the Hermès.com Terms and Conditions, you consent to the collection, the use and the disclosure of your information, including personal and financial information, by HERMÈS INTERNATIONAL on the terms described in this Privacy Policy. If you do not agree with the terms of this Privacy Policy, or any modifications thereto, please exit the Hermès.com website now and do not purchase any of the Hermès products offered for sale on the website.

What information is collected on Hermès.com?

You may use the Hermès.com website without providing any personal information to HERMÈS INTERNATIONAL. You will however, need to provide certain information, including your name, address, telephone number and e-mail address, as well as certain financial information (such as your charge or credit card number) if you choose to purchase products offered on the Hermès.com website for the purposes of paying for the products you ordered and processing your order. Any information you provide on the Hermès.com website may be processed in Portugal or in France and will be stored on HERMÈS INTERNATIONAL's server in France.

Receiving information

HERMÈS INTERNATIONAL also provides you with the opportunity to receive information from the HERMÈS group, which may be of interest to you, including information relating to Hermès products and new products offered on the Hermès.com website. If you do not want to receive such information by e-mail, you may opt-out of further communications at any time by contacting our Customer Service Department by e-mail at service.pt@hermes.com or by calling us at +800 43005757.

What use is made of the information you provide on Hermès.com?

HERMÈS INTERNATIONAL may share information that you submit to the Hermès.com website with HERMÈS SELLIER in order to process your order and to combat attempts at fraudulent online payments. As regards combatting fraudulent online payments, HERMÈS SELLIER, in the capacity of data controller, may share your financial information with a third-party service provider using an online fraud detection tool in order to verify your payment.

HERMÈS INTERNATIONAL may also disclose the information you provide on the Hermès.com website to other companies in the HERMÈS group, in order that such corporate affiliates may contact you with respect to information about such corporate affiliates, including products and services of such corporate affiliates that may be of interest to you. Information about cookies

What is a cookie?

A cookie is a small text file stored on your computer, tablet or mobile phone that makes it possible to save and track data about your use of the website. Hermes.com uses cookies to identify you or store your product selection in your basket, for example. Cookies are managed by your Internet browser.

What cookies do we use?

There are two types of cookies on our website:

- Cookies strictly necessary for the website to function

These cookies allow you to use the main features of the Hermes.com website, such as storing your product selection in your basket. These cookies make browsing easier and are required to make online purchases.

- Third-party cookies

These are particularly statistical analysis cookies that collect information about navigation on our website, thereby enabling us to improve your user experience and tailor the services to your preferences. There are also advertising cookies that aim to personalise and/or improve the content and browsing experience by providing you with interest-based services on other websites.

All of the information collected is anonymous.
